



## Race Management Positions

Portchester Sailing Club is seeking to appoint suitably qualified and experienced people to supplement club volunteers to run Club Racing. There are 3 positions available Race Officer, Safety Boat Driver and Safety Boat Crew.

### Race Officer

#### Job Description

- Required to act as club race officer at PSC for evening and weekend racing usually from the club start hut but occasionally from the club committee boat.
- Required to attend from 45 mins prior to start (60 mins for a Committee Boat)
- Race duration usually 60-90 minutes.
- Processing of Race results using race results software (Sailwave)

#### Qualities and Qualifications

- Experience in race management, the Racing Rules of Sailing and club racing
- Competent VHF Radio user – licence holder desirable

### Safety Boat Driver / Crew

#### Job Description

- Required to act as safety boat driver at PSC for Dinghy racing
- Required to attend from 45 mins prior to start, do pre-race checks, launch and recover RIB, lay and recover temporary race marks, monitor racing dinghies and offer assistance as required.
- Post race checks of RIB, put away and secure and defect reporting,
- Race duration usually 60-90 minutes.

#### Qualities and Qualifications

- RYA Powerboat Level II is an essential requirement.
- Competent VHF Radio user – licence holder preferred
- RYA Safety Boat or Intermediate/Advanced Powerboat desirable.
- Experience in RIB driving in a Safety boat context desirable.

Portchester Sailing Club mainly runs racing on Wednesday and Friday evenings and Saturdays around high water between mid April and mid October. A flexible approach will be adopted as to what shifts/duties are filled by employed staff and which are completed by Club members.
